Say **NO** – UNiTE to End Violence against Women

Starting November 2009

WHAT: Say **NO** – UNiTE to End Violence against Women is a global call for action on ending violence against women and girls. It is presented by UNIFEM as a contribution to advance the objectives of UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon's campaign UNiTE to End Violence against Women through social mobilization.

Say **NO** triggers and highlights actions by individuals, governments, UN and civil society partners in support of ending violence against women and girls. Actions can range from adding your name to **Say NO**, advocating for legislation to reaching out to students at schools or donating funds towards the UN Trust Fund that supports local organizations on the ground. Every action is counted to showcase the global groundswell of engagement that exists on the issue, urging governments to make ending violence against women and girls a top priority.

The initial goal is to reach 100,000 actions by March 2010.

WHO: Say **NO** amplifies your voice on the issue.

The United Nations Secretary-General calls for stepping up action.
